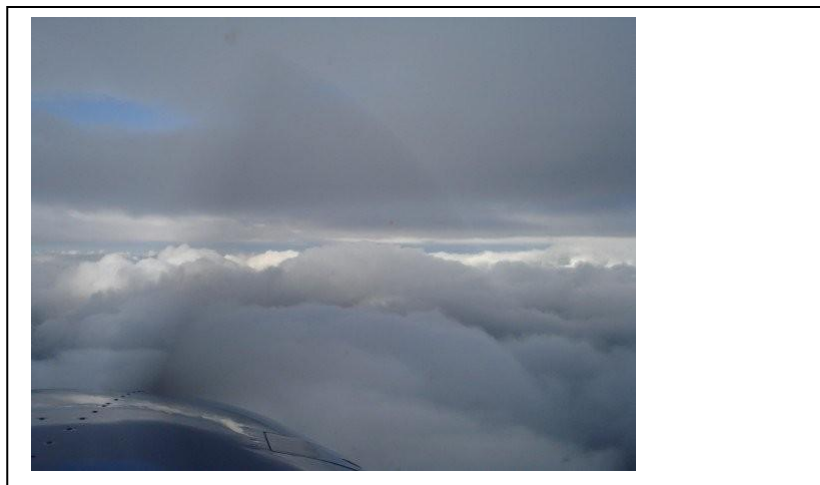

In January, NNA and 2 new students began using Cessna's new web based instruction kit for Private Pilot Training. Advantages for the student include : use at any computer, better explanation in the flight video, a Library attached in order to reference other resources like the FAR/AIM, greater in-depth information before taking the quizzes, and an opportunity to interact and evaluate with the Instructor regarding the progress of the flight. The new web-based program is far more involved than the previous CD program and requires the Instructor to explain to the student the numerous aspects of it. Three training concepts that are enhanced and incorporated in the new program are: Risk Management, Decision Making, and Cockpit Resource Management; all very good and important ingredients in the making of new, safety aware pilots. Again, whether you use the old program or the new web-based one, arriving on time for your lesson well rested, prepared and unhurried, with a fully powered-up meal will lead to a more productive lesson for you.
