

# Aircraft Rental Agreement

- 1) The following applies to all students and renters known herein as the Aviator.
- 2) On each flight made by the Aviator subsequent to this date, in equipment owned or operated by Northern Nevada Aviation, the Aviator agrees to the to comply with the following terms listed herein or subsequent revisions thereof posted on the NNA website.
- 3) Aviator hereby expressly acknowledges and binds the Aviator, the Aviators heirs and assigns for all liabilities to pay Northern Nevada Aviation the following:
  - a. Service and time charges computed at the applicable rate as specified at the time of rental.
  - b. A sum equal to the cost of all damages to the aircraft, or loss of equipment of the aircraft during the rental period as well as any damages to their person or other persons in whole or in part by failure to comply with the rules and regulations of the Federal Aviation Administration, the terms of this Agreement, the procedures outlined in the Northern Nevada Aviation Operations Manual, the Aeronautical Information Manual or any other laws and statutes applicable to the operation of the rented aircraft.
- 4) Aviator agrees to return the aircraft at the agreed time, weather and safety permitting, in the same manner in which it was received, normal wear and tear excepted.
- 5) Aviator agrees that if the aircraft is left or abandoned at any location other than Northern Nevada Aviation, for other than mechanical or safety reasons, the Aviator will pay the expenses involved in returning the aircraft to Northern Nevada Aviation.
  - a. If the Aviator must abandon the aircraft due to mechanical or safety reasons, the Aviator must contact Northern Nevada Aviation, during normal business hours, and make arrangements to either fix and retrieve the aircraft and/or make alternate travel plans for the Aviator and passengers. At its sole discretion, Northern Nevada Aviation will make commercially reasonable efforts to fix the aircraft or make alternate travel arrangements for the Aviator and his passengers. Northern Nevada Aviation will not be liable for any arrangements made without its consent.
- 6) Aviator agrees to pay for any parking fees, landing fees, legal violations or any other fees assessed against Northern Nevada Aviation as a result of the Aviators operation of the rented aircraft.
- 7) The Aviator agrees not to allow any other persons to fly the aircraft, Northern Nevada Aviation Certified Flight Instructors excepted.
- 8) Aviator agrees to abide by the Northern Nevada Aviation Operations Manual.
- 9) Aviator agrees to observe and comply with all Federal Aviation Regulations.
- 10) Aviator is responsible for any and all damage caused the Aviator's negligence or failure to operate the airplane in a safe manner or damage attributed to pilot error.
- 11) Aviator agrees not to deliberately land the rented aircraft at airports not approved by NNA, unimproved or unpaved runways or "off airport" except when required to ensure the safety of the flight.
- 12) The Aviator will report all accidents, whether major or minor, to Northern Nevada Aviation as soon as practicable, together with the names and addresses of witnesses and involved parties, and in the event of an accident, will not move the airplane unless authorized by Northern Nevada Aviation.
- 13) The Aviator will not tamper with, molest or attempt to repair any part of the aircraft or its accessories, but will contact Northern Nevada Aviation (collect if required) for instructions as to what to do in the event of a malfunction of any part of the aircraft or its accessories.
- 14) Aviator is strongly encouraged to obtain Aircraft Renters Insurance from a reputable aircraft insurance agency.
- 15) Aviator will pay Northern Nevada Aviation attorney's fees incurred by Northern Nevada Aviation in the collection of any costs that are responsibility of the Aviator.
